Dear MCMA Member,

The Metropolitan Club Foundation established the Keith Roth Scholarship in memory of MCMA member Keith Roth who while serving on MCMA's Board dedicated most of his time to the Association's scholarship endeavors. This scholarship memorializes all of his efforts to raise meaningful funds for student scholarships.

This scholarship is open to graduate or undergraduate students currently enrolled as a full-time student studying hospitality management or allied professions. We encourage you to pass this information along to any qualified student. The deadline for applications to be received is Thursday, December 5th.

Eligibility

Students currently enrolled in graduate or undergraduate studies at an accredited college (two or four year) studying Club Management, Hotel or Restaurant Management, or Allied Professions with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5. Graduate students must be currently enrolled in an accredited hospitality program.

All applicants must have completed a minimum of one 12 credit semester.

Guidelines

All applicants must submit as part of their application:

- 1) A fully completed scholarship application form.
- 2) A typewritten essay outlining career goals, as well as the reason for applying and explaining how being a recipient of this scholarship would help them achieve their career goals (minimum 400 words).
- 3) A letter of recommendation from a Professional MCMA member.
- 4) An official copy of their current transcript.
- 5) A current resume.

The scholarship award is made directly to the registrar at the college or university the recipient attends and will be paid for the spring 2020 semester. Scholarships are not guaranteed upon submission of a scholarship application. Scholarship awards are made at the recommendation of The Keith Roth Scholarship Committee and approved by the Metropolitan Club Foundation Board.
