We would like to announce the release of this year's **ERIC CASPERS FOOD AND WINE SCHOLARSHIP**. This scholarship is open to full-time club employees who wish to further their studies in food and wine education.

The scholarship was established in memory of Eric Caspers who was the long-time general manager of Beach Point Club, until his retirement in 1998 and past President of our Chapter. Those who were fortunate enough to know the late Eric Caspers recall his elegant, gracious manner and his love of the finer things that life had to offer, especially outstanding food and wine. This Scholarship gives our Chapter the opportunity to celebrate his memory in a manner he would appreciate.

We invite you to apply for this Scholarship by Sunday, October 25th. Scholarship winners will be announced at this year's Annual Meeting.

ELIGIBILITY

- Full-time club employees managed by a Professional member of MCMA are eligible to apply. Association membership for the applicant is not required.
- Previous winners are not eligible.
- Members or relatives of members of the Metropolitan Club Foundation Board of Directors or Eric Caspers Scholarship Committee are ineligible.

GUIDELINES

- All applicants must submit as part of their application: (1) a completed scholarship application form; (2) a current resume; (3) a typed essay outlining the reason for applying, as well as a summary of their career goals and explaining how they would use the scholarship to further study food and wine (minimum 500 words) and (4) a letter of recommendation from a Professional member of MCMA.
- If awarded, this scholarship will assist with tuition expenses related to CMAA Food or Wine BMI's, International Wine Society trips or similar types of food and wine education.
- Winners should submit registration forms or receipts within 24 months of winning to collect scholarship. Reimbursements will only be made to the institution directly or as a reimbursement to recipient's club.

Anyone interested in applying for this scholarship should scan (as one attachment) their application, resume, essay and letter of recommendation and e-mail it to info@metcf.org no later than 10/25. Late applications will not be considered.
