



FREDERIC GOLDMANN SCHOLARSHIP

FOR METROPOLITAN CHAPTER ASSISTANT MANAGERS

SUMMARY

This scholarship provides funding to attend CMAA's Mid-Management Conference, World Conference or any of their Business Management Institute programs.

ELIGIBILITY

The applicant must be a full-time employee of a private club managed by a current member of the Metropolitan Chapter.

The applicant must have one full years experience in the private club industry.

Applicant need not be a current CMAA member.

For the purpose of this scholarship, all reference to Assistant Managers refers to all mid-level management positions (i.e. Clubhouse Managers, F&B Managers, Dining Room Managers, Membership Directors).

GUIDELINES

All applicants must submit:

- 1) An **online application form**.
- 2) An **essay** detailing their reasons for applying. The essay should include info on how the candidate hopes to utilize the scholarship, as well as explaining career goals, what financial support they are given at their club and info on how they engage/contribute with the local Chapter (min. 500 words).
- 3) A **letter of recommendation** from a member of the Metropolitan Chapter supporting the application and explaining why the candidate should be considered for an award.
- 4) Current **resume**.
