SUMMARY

This scholarship is open to full-time club employees who wish to further their study of food and wine.

ERIC CASPERS

Eric Caspers who was the long-time general manager of Beach Point Club, until his retirement in 1998 and past President of our Chapter. Those who were fortunate enough to know Eric recall his elegant, gracious manner and his love of the finer things that life had to offer, especially outstanding food and wine. This Scholarship gives us the opportunity to celebrate his memory in a manner he would appreciate.

ELIGIBILITY

Open to full-time club employees managed by a Professional member of the Metropolitan Chapter are eligible to apply. Association membership for the applicant is not required.

GUIDELINES

All applicants must submit:

- 1) An online application form.
- 2) An essay outlining the reason for applying, as well as a summary of their career goals and explaining how they would use the scholarship to further study food and wine (minimum 500 words).
- 3) Current resume.
- 4) A letter of recommendation from a member of the Metropolitan Chapter.

STEPS FOR APPLYING

APPLICATION FORM

ESSAY/RESUME

Send one email to md@metcma.org and attach a single PDF of your completed essay and resume.

LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION

The manager letter of recommendation should be e-mailed directly from the Metropolitan chapter member to md@metcma.org by the deadline.

DEADLINE

All of these items must be complete by Monday, October 31st for consideration.

MISCELLANEOUS

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Scholarships are not guaranteed upon submission of an application and awards based on availability of funds and vary in amounts.

Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

Previous winners are not eligible.

If awarded, this scholarship will assist with tuition expenses related to CMAA Food or Wine BMI's, International Wine Society trips or similar types of food and wine education.

Winners should submit registration forms or receipts within 24 months of winning to collect scholarship. Reimbursements will only be made to the institution directly or as a reimbursement to recipient's club.

Recipients will be announced at the fall Wine Dinner.
