SUMMARY

This scholarship provides funding to attend CMAA's Mid-Management Conference, World Conference or any of their Business Management Institute programs.

ELIGIBILITY

Open to full-time Professional members of the Metropolitan Chapter of CMAA.

For the purpose of this scholarship, all reference to Assistant Managers refers to all mid-level management positions below the level of GM (i.e. Clubhouse Managers, F&B Managers, Dining Room Managers, Membership Directors, etc.).

GUIDELINES

All applicants must submit:

- 1) An **online application form**.
- 2) An **essay** detailing their reasons for applying. The essay must include info on how the candidate plans to utilize the scholarship, as well as explaining career goals, what financial support they are given at their club and info on how they engage and contribute with the local Chapter (min. 500 words).
- 3) A **letter of recommendation** from a member of the Metropolitan Chapter supporting the application and explaining why the candidate should be considered for an award.
- 4) Current **resume**.

Previous scholarship recipients are not eligible to reapply.

Scholarship awards must be used within 18 months of receipt.

Recipients will be announced at the 2026 Annual Meeting in November.
