## SUMMARY

This scholarship was established in honor of a steadfast ally, respected advisor, and dear friend of the Metropolitan Chapter. It provides financial assistance to full-time club employees pursuing advanced education in fields that reflect Dan's expertise, including:

- Master of Business Administration (MBA) degrees
- Accounting or finance degrees
- Continuing education or certifications related to club management or business (outside of CMAA-provided programs)

## GUIDELINES

All applicants must submit:

1) An **online application form**.

2) Please address the following prompts in a single **essay**:

- *How does this educational opportunity align with your career goals in the private club industry?*
- *Why are you seeking this scholarship?*
- *What impact will it have on your ability to complete this program?*
- *Dan Condon was known for his integrity, humility, mentorship, and passion for education. How do you reflect these values in your work or life?*
- *You may also include any other information that strengthens your application.*

3) A **letter of recommendation** from a member of the Metropolitan Chapter supporting the application and explaining why the candidate should be considered for an award.

4) Current **resume**.

All of these items must be complete by Thursday, October 1<sup>st</sup> for consideration.
