Dear MCMA Member:

The **FREDERIC GOLDMANN SCHOLARSHIP** was established to provide an opportunity for Assistant Managers to further their education and development in the club management field by providing funds to attend CMAA's Mid-Management Conference, World Conference or any of their Business Management Institute programs.

It is our hope that by encouraging participation in education programs offered by CMAA, we will contribute to the development of extraordinary leaders with a sense of passion and commitment to club management, the profession Freddie loved and participated in so proudly. For the purpose of this scholarship, all reference to Assistant Managers also includes Clubhouse Managers, Food and Beverage Managers and Dining Room Managers.

ELIGIBILITY

The applicant must be a full-time employee of a private club managed by a current member of MCMA.

The applicant must have one full years' experience in the private club industry.

Association membership for the applicant is not required.

Previous winners are not eligible.

GUIDELINES

The applicant's General Manger must submit a letter nominating the candidate, explaining why the candidate should be considered for an award.

The applicant must write a one-page (500 word) essay detailing their reasons for applying. The essay should include information on how the candidate hopes to utilize the scholarship, as well as explaining their career goals, what financial support they are given at their club and information on their activity within the chapter.

Completed packets include a signed application, personal essay, manager's letter of recommendation and current resume.

Winners will submit registration forms or receipts within 12 months of winning to collect the scholarship. Payments will ideally be made in the form of registration to CMAA or as a reimbursement to the club. No monies will be reimbursed to any individual.

We encourage you to give the enclosed scholarship application to your assistant, clubhouse manager and/or beverage manager and have them submit it via email to md@metcma.org before Sunday, October 25th. Winners will be announced this November at MCMA's Annual Meeting.
