Dear MCMA Member,

It is time to begin our search for those exceptional hospitality students who may be deserving of a 2017 Keith Roth Scholarship. This scholarship is open to graduate or undergraduate students currently enrolled as a full-time student studying hospitality management or allied professions.

This scholarship was established in memory of MCMA member Keith Roth who while serving on MCMA's Board dedicated most of his time to the Association's scholarship endeavors. This scholarship memorializes all of his work and the influence he had on students because of his efforts to raise meaningful funds.

We encourage you to pass this information along to any qualified student. The deadline for applications to be received is Monday, October 16<sup>th</sup>.

Eligibility

Students currently enrolled in graduate or undergraduate studies at an accredited college (two or four year) studying Club Management, Hotel or Restaurant Management, or Allied Professions with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5.

All applicants must have completed a minimum of one 12 credit semester.

Guidelines

All applications must be sponsored by a current MCMA member and include their letter of recommendation no later than October 16<sup>th</sup>.

All applicants must submit as part of their application: (1) a fully completed scholarship application form; (2) a typewritten essay outlining career goals, as well as the reason for applying and how the scholarship will help them achieve their goals (minimum 400 words); (3) a letter of recommendation from a MCMA member; (4) an official copy of their current transcript and (5) a current resume.

Graduate students must be currently enrolled in an accredited hospitality program.

The scholarship award is made directly to the registrar at the college or university the recipient attends and will be paid for the spring 2018 semester.

Scholarship awards are made at the recommendation of The Keith Roth Scholarship Committee and approved by the Metropolitan Club Foundation Board. If you have any questions, please feel free to e-mail the committee at [info@metcf.org](mailto:info@metcf.org).
